Fermented and barrel aged in French Oak barrels for 12 months, 33% new barrels. Underwent full 100% malolactic fermentation

408 cases grown, produced and bottled.

The Estate Chardonnay block enjoys a sunny, southern exposure. High elevation, complex soils and a long, slow ripening ensure intense fruit flavors.

Here’s Dave’s latest Estate-grown Chardonnay. A lovely lemony-straw color in the glass opens up to a nose of toast, citrus and honey. This is a zesty Chardonnay with juicy flavors of grapefruit, almonds, melon and tropical fruit. The lively acidity begs to be enjoyed with equally lively fare. We vote for freshly shucked oysters.
